What is KOTO?

Koto is a traditional Japanese wooden musical instrument similar to a zither and is usually played by women. It is about 180 cm length and has thirteen strings strung over 13 movable bridges along the width of the instrument. Players can adjust the string pitches by moving the white bridges before playing.
